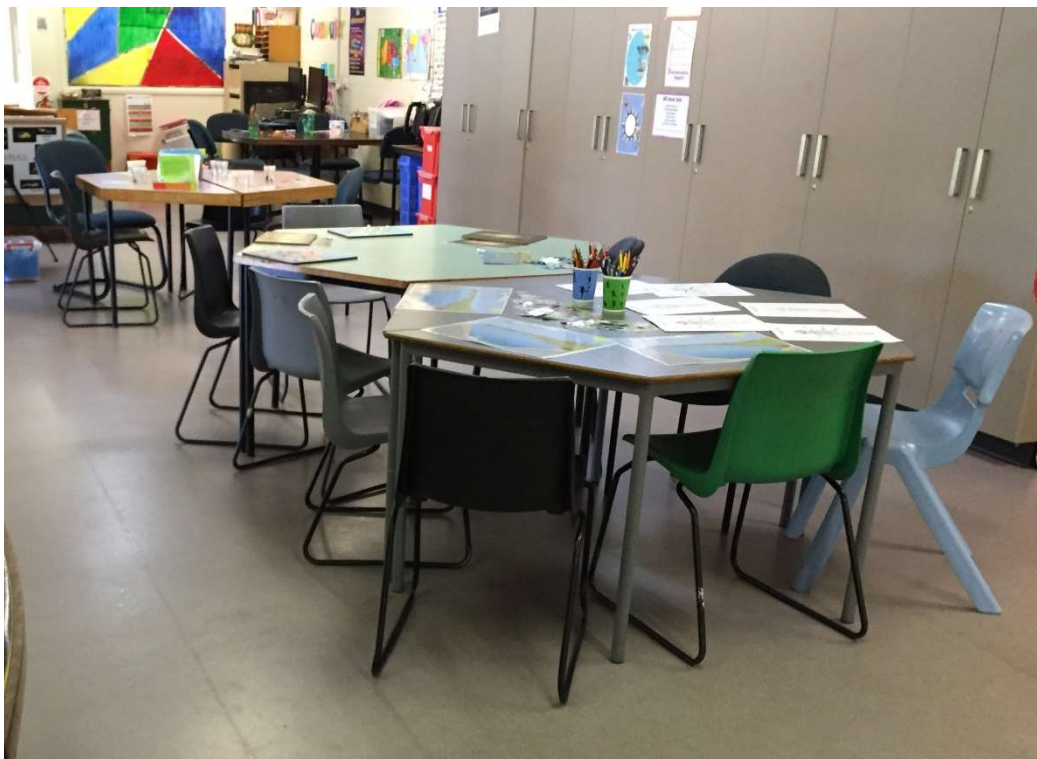
Set-up requirements for kindergarten workshops

Having access to the right presentation space will enhance the Waterbug Wonders experience for children and teachers. In an ideal situation, we like to be able to split the class into two groups so that half of the class are outside catching waterbugs, and the other half of the class are completing inside activities. The two groups can then completely focus on the task at hand and are not distracted by what the other group are doing (particularly catching waterbugs!). The two groups are swapped over after 10 minutes.

Below is a photo of the ideal outside set-up. We need enough tables under cover to comfortably sit half of the class with a tray and seat for each child.



Below are some photos of the ideal inside set-up. We generally need a floor area for the oral presentation part of the workshop, and three to four large tables for setting-up activity stations.



And of course, all of this takes time! We will need access to the space for 30 minutes prior to the start time to effectively set-up our equipment.
